The following are some guidelines that help the PTA distribute any scholarships awarded for Panda Club programs in a fair and responsible manner while maintaining the privacy of the scholarship applicant as best we can.

We will assume that anyone applying is in need of a scholarship and will not ask for verification.

- o All scholarship applications are due by Wednesday, December 18th.
- Panda Club Scholarship recipients are selected by the Panda Club Coordinators. Preference may be given to those families
 who are members of the PTA. Other considerations include previous participation in the program, ability to participate, and
 additional support that can be provided by the family.
- You can request a partial scholarship or a full scholarship. If you are able to contribute some portion of the class fee (and are applying for a partial scholarship for the remainder) please contribute that portion with this form. If we are not able to provide a scholarship for the remainder, your contribution will be returned in full via check from the PTA.
- The Panda Club Coordinators will do their best to accommodate each applicant's first choice of classes, but class preference cannot be guaranteed. Please indicate two or three clubs of interest to the student.
